The CCN provides professional support for the Bishops of England and Wales and the wider Church in promoting the Gospel through the media on current issues. The office of the CCN is the focus for media enquiries. It seeks to develop the public profile of the Church and its teaching. It coordinated the successful media coverage of the visit of Pope Benedict XVI to the UK. The CCN provides up to date news releases, features and podcasts, information from the Bishops' Conference of England and Wales, and trains spokesmen and women.
