From the Parish Priest

There is a passage in the Gospel of St. John which speaks about Jesus' zeal or passion in the context of his visit to the Temple of Jerusalem. When we hear about Jesus' zeal we can also read it as God's passion, God's zeal. Jesus was strongly concerned about His Father's house which, instead of being a house of prayer, became a market place. If we do not suffer from a spiritual indifference we know that we go to Church, our Father's house, not to get angry but to pray and to experience God's love and respect which bring us inner peace. Jesus' passion was to fulfil the will of God his Father. And His Fatherly will is still the same: that all may get to know the truth and be saved; that all may recognise Jesus as their Redeemer and find their salvation in Him. Jesus' zeal for each one of us is still the same: He wants to save us because each one of us, every baptised person, is His house, the house of His Father and the Temple of the Holy Spirit.
