Face coverings in church: Following the Government announcement last week, face coverings must now be worn in places of worship. All parishioners, apart from children under 11, and those with certain health conditions who are exempt, should wear a face mask, scarf or other face covering. We politely request that you comply with this directive, but also please remember that not all disabilities are visible, so please be understanding of parishioners who may not be able to follow this rule.

We will seat three people wearing face coverings in each available pew (five if from the same household) meaning that our minimum capacity is now 48 people.

**First Holy Communion 2020:** Please register a place for your child at any of the weekday or weekend Masses by emailing or telephoning the parish office.

**Please pray for** Noah Busby, Harry Telford, Desife Adegun and Joshua Graham who will be receiving the sacrament at Masses this week.

First Holy Communion 2021: Parents of children entering YEAR 3 in September 2020 who would like their child to receive the sacrament in 2021 should complete the application form which is now available on the website (see the "Sacramental" pages).

The deadline for applications is 30<sup>th</sup> September 2020; applications received after this date will not be allocated a place on the programme.

**Confirmation 2020:** This year's candidates will receive the sacrament of Confirmation at a special Mass on **Thursday 17**<sup>th</sup> **September at 7.30pm.** All candidates will receive further information about the Mass from Fr. Stanislaw.

**Volunteer stewards: Can you help?** We still need to increase our team of stewards; please get in touch with the Parish Office and Maria will explain your role in more detail.

Volunteer cleaners: Can you help? We are looking for volunteers to wipe down the pews, door handles, etc. in preparation for the Saturday 6.00pm Mass (this could be done any time after the 9.15am Mass on Friday, and 5.00pm on Saturday) and after the 8.30 Mass on Sunday. All cleaning materials, face masks and gloves will be provided.

Your support with these roles is critical if we are to be able to sustain the celebration of public Masses.
