Dear Parishioners and Visitors of St John the Evangelist

We continue to maintain all necessary safety measures. The capacity of our building is between 48 and 80 persons with social distancing of 1m; the total number will depend on how many groups of five people from one household attend.

Face coverings must be worn by everyone apart from children under 11, and those with certain health conditions who are exempt.

When you enter the Church, please take the seats available starting from the first benches (this means you may have to abandon your "usual places" for a while 😊).

We have our Lord's mind means the Church is the House of God's real presence: Please do not walk around the Church for a chat before the Mass.

Please do not use either St John's or Our Lady's Chapel.

The Holy Communion is within the Mass. Please approach from the main aisle, starting from the first benches, and return to you places by side aisles.

After the Final Blessing and your private prayer, please leave the Church by the side doors.

Please do not gather for a chat in the Church which is the House of Prayer; please do that in the car park.

Please do not bring in any leaflets / booklets for sharing in the Church.

Please do not leave Missalettes in the Church but take them with you after the Mass; they are one time use only.

Confessions will be heard in the sacristy during our regular times and days or by appointment. Please enter the sacristy using the door on the side of the church where the presbytery is.
